Dear Resident

As you know from previous communications, we have tirelessly lobbied Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council re the installation of single yellow lines (similar to Balally Drive) on Balally Park to control dangerous parking.

Despite the support of the Garda traffic unit, the submission of a petition, photos, survey results, reports from emergency services and a waste removal company, we are disappointed to report that our request was turned down by the Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council Traffic Department.

We have attached the response which we were extremely disappointed with – especially to read that they deem the reason for our request was simply to control “nuisance parking”.

Since receipt of this letter, your committee have had several communications with Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council and have argued against their decisions. However, recently certain conditions were offered :

To give better visibility of the roads being accessed, DLRCC will install double yellow lines at the junctions on Balally Park. For example, double yellow lines would be put in place from the roundabout to No. 2, Balally Park.

These same measures can be put in place at every junction in Balally if required.

The committee feel we have currently exhausted all options, and in the interest of safety, we will apply to Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council to go ahead and install the double yellow lines at the junctions on Balally Park.
