- Aim to have your garden in full bloom by July

Road and street appearance

- Maintain your grass verge, cut the grass & edge the verge
- Help older neighbours with their verges
- Weed & sweep path areas outside your home
- Consider re-seeding if your verge is damaged
- Do not park on the grass verges
- Participate in our Estate Clean-Up Week 10th – 16th June
